

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Shelly Haas, Daryl Sherraden, and Ryan Weltmer. James Balthazor and Deb Meyers were absent.

Haas moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from December 17, 2019. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Sherraden moved to pay bills in the amount of \$141,716.59. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Andrew Casey with the Plainville Recreation Commission inquired as to possibility of advertising on the City's L.E.D. sign. There were no objections.

- The Plainville Housing Authority has requested \$5,000.00 in gap funding for new heating and cooling systems that have been installed. After discussion:

Compliance Officer Mandy Bice reported:

- The 2020 animal licenses are now being sold.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- He, and KDHE, have been actively monitoring sporadic discoloration of the City's water. All testing has met KDHE's requirements.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- The real estate closing between the City and Van Dyke is now complete. He will begin the annexation process for the newly acquired property.

Councilmember Ryan Weltmer reported:

- Various banner designs have been received and are now being considered.

Weltmer moved to adjourn the meeting. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:12 PM.
