- Reviewed the website design.


Jerry Hageman reported:

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Policy manual is being reviewed by City Attorney Michael Baxter.
- Would like an executive session to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body, City Attorney Michael Baxter, and Police Chief Troy Rudman to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 7:45 PM. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Governing Body, City Attorney Michael Baxter, and Police Chief Troy Rudman returned to the table at 7:45 PM.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to hire Lee Vogel as a full-time police officer with an hourly wage of \$17.50 and health insurance to begin at the earliest convenience. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Council discussed the potential purchase of a drug dog. Police Officer Lee Vogel is a certified canine handler.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow the purchase of a drug dog from the Ness County Sheriff's office for \$10,000.00 with the funds to be taken from the Special Law Enforcement fund. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Sherraden moved to adjourn the meeting. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:27 PM.
