

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were, Matt Whitney, Skylar Rudman, and Frank Austin. James Balthazor and Ryan Weltmer were absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Whitney moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- Corrected October 2, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$426,230.36
- Gorham Communications invoice \$1,549.00
- ESO invoice \$1,501.06

Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Applications for the Physical Improvement Program were reviewed. After discussion:

- Whitney moved to approve and fund a grant of \$2,500.00 and a loan of \$7,500.00, from the Industrial Development Fund, for the applications submitted by Tyler’s Automotive and Paradise Flats Gifts and Florals. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Ordinance G-25-01 was presented and discussed.

- Rudman moved to approve ordinance G-25-01 as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Major Concrete gave an estimate of \$45,967.00 for replacing and area of North 4th Street.
 - ◆ Rudman moved to approve the replacement, as listed in the Capital Improvement Plan, for a cost not to exceed \$56,000.00. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- EBH Engineering is surveying additional areas to add to the current Phase 1 Water Project.
- The loader has been delivered, and the snowplow has been ordered.
- Approximately 75 banners need replacement.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- Main Street Development may have a plan for the building addressed as 217 and 219 W Mill Street. More information will be forthcoming.

Whitney moved to adjourn the meeting. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:24PM.
