

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Colton Wise, James Balthazor, Ryan Weltmer, Deb Meyers, and Daryl Sherraden.

All stood for the flag salute.

Sherraden moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from December 1, 2020. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$109,044.96. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions there was no public hearing as advertised in Resolution number 226. A new resolution and hearing date will be presented for Council consideration at a future date.

Discussion has held on the proposed Ordinance G-20-10 that would make changes to local nuisance regulations. After discussion:

- Sherraden moved to approve Ordinance Number G-20-10 as presented. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Standard and Poor's Global Rating Service has affirmed an A/Stable rating on Plainville's general obligation debt.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Several City owned vehicles have been sold at auction by Purple Wave, Inc. A check will be sent once all transactions have been finalized.

Councilmember Colton Wise reported:

- Has concerns about an unsightly property. No action can be taken as it is outside the City limits.

Councilmember Ryan Weltmer reported:

- Heartland Community Foundation has awarded \$4,440.00 in grant funds for the purchase of City Christmas Decorations.


Councilmember Daryl Sherraden reported:
