

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were, Daryl Sherraden, Colton Wise, James Balthazor, and Skylar Rudman. Deb Meyers was absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Sherraden moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from February 1, 2022. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$346,816.10. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Kathy Ramsey with Heartland Community Foundation informed the Council of the "Twice as Nice" fundraising campaign that is happening in the month of February.

- Balthazor moved to contribute \$5,000.00 to the Foundation's "Twice as Nice" campaign. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mike Selbe addressed the Council as to the condition of his property and the time needed for bring the property into compliance with City Code. The Council asked for his return at the March 15<sup>th</sup> meeting.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- There has been interest from business owners regarding the City's Physical Improvement Project.

Police Sergeant Lee Vogel reported:

- The department will be donating \$1,500.00 to the County's DARE Program.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Will be performing maintenance procedures on three water wells.
- Will begin trimming trees that infringe into street rights-of-way.
- Will get costs for sewer lagoon preventive maintenance.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- The aluminum air packs approved for purchase at the last meeting have a shorter lifespan and warranty than carbon fiber packs. After discussion:
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow the purchase of eight new air packs from the Special Fire Fund for cost not to exceed \$13,000.00. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The department will have a fund-raising golf tournament on April 30<sup>th</sup>.


City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- Currently researching legalities of certain property locations for entrance sign placement.


Councilmember Daryl Sherraden reported:
