Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$142,734.80. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Tony Burnett with the Western Kansas Child Advocacy Center updated the Council as to the various past, present, and future services the group provides throughout Western Kansas.

- Balthazor moved to donate \$2,000.00 to Western Kansas Child Advocacy Center. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.


City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- An audit agreement proposal for fiscal year 2020 in the amount of \$9,250.00 was received from Mapes & Miller and needs approval.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the agreement in the amount of \$9,250.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Fire Department would like to apply for a grant that would be used to purchase and replace the departments bunker gear. They would like to have a Council approved match for up to half the cost. After discussion:
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow up to half the cost of new bunker gear, not to exceed \$25,000.00, to be written into the grant application and to come out of the Special Fire Fund. Balthazor seconded them motion. The motion passed.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- Fire truck number 508 is in the process of being repaired. EMC Insurance has been made aware of the circumstances of the damage.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 PM.
