

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were, Daryl Sherraden, Colton Wise, James Balthazor, Deb Meyers, and Skylar Rudman.

All stood for the flag salute.

Sherraden moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from March 1, 2022. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$57,804.03. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Paul Gross with Plainville Insurance Agency presented the proposed 2022-2023 EMC insurance premium.

- Balthazor moved to accept the proposal as presented in the amount of \$98,781.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mike Selbe updated the Council as to the progress made abating the nuisances addressed at his property. The Council would like Selbe to return with another update at the April 19th regular meeting.

Bee Reif addressed the Council as to her business plans and progress to date.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- Truck #508 needs repairs costing approximately \$2,200.00.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow the repairs for a cost not to exceed \$2,200.00. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Would like to purchase a weed spraying trailer for the price of \$2,923.00.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow the purchase of the trailer for a cost not to exceed \$3,000.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- K-Lawn estimated the cost of spraying the ball fields and the City park to be \$10,149.48.
 - ◆ Deb Meyers moved to allow K-Lawn to spray the ball fields and City park for the cost of \$10,149.48. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Councilmember Daryl Sherraden reported:

 - ◆ Sherraden moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel, to protect the privacy of those involved, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 8:13 PM. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

- ◆ The Governing Body returned to the Council Chamber at 8:13 PM.
- ◆ Balthazor moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel, to protect the privacy of those involved, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 8:18 PM. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- ◆ The Governing Body returned to the Council Chamber at 8:18 PM.
- ◆ Sherraden moved to hire Michelle Dougherty as the Pool Manager for \$500.00 per week and Shelby Paramore as the Assistant Pool Manager for \$400.00 per week. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:24 PM.
