

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, James Balthazor, and Frank Austin. Matt Whitney and Skylar Rudman were absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- March 4, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$119,187.37
- Blaine's Electric invoice \$8,297.51

Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Paul Gross with Plainville Insurance Agency presented the proposed 2025-2026 EMC insurance premium.

- Weltmer moved to accept the proposal as presented in the amount of \$131,220.00. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Kelli Hansen and Tasha Eichman explained the community branding concept that a strategic doing committee has working to implement.

Collins Refuse would like to purchase five three-yard dumpsters for a cost of \$962.00 each.

- Balthazor moved to allow the purchase for a cost not to exceed \$5,000.00. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Midco Diving gave an estimate of \$3,876.00 for reservoir cleaning.
  - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the reservoir cleaning for a cost not to exceed \$4,000.00. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The pump for the water slide will cost \$6,395.00.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to replace the water slide pump for a cost not to exceed \$7,000.00. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden reported:

- Presented an event license for the public library.
  - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the license as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Will begin accepting applications for a school crossing guard.

City Councilmember Ryan Weltmer reported:

- The aquatic area will open Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend.
- Would like an executive session for the discussion of non-elected personnel.
- Moved to recess into executive session to discuss matters involving non-elected personnel, to include Mayor, Council, and City Attorney to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 7:55 PM. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
  - ◆ The Mayor, Council, and City Attorney returned to the Council Chamber at 7:55 PM with no action taken.
