

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, James Balthazor, and Ryan Weltmer.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Haas moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from February 19, 2019. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$76,593.96. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Snow removal has been a challenge due to the large amounts of snow in a short time. Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman spoke with Love's Convenience about using their empty property to dump snow removed from the streets. There was no objection for that use by owner.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Plans for a multi-governmental task force are underway. Chief Wise will inform the Council of the details as they become available.
