

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, James Balthazor, Skylar Rudman, Matt Whitney, and Frank Austin.

All stood for the flag salute.

Weltmer moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- April 1, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$141,807.78
- Superior Athletics invoice for \$2,931.25
- Collins Refuse invoice for \$3,951.60

Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Jamie Dewey with the Plainville Public Library addressed the council as to the state of the library and detailed the past and future planned activities being offered. Discussion was held regarding the annual liability insurance. There were no objections to no longer billing the library for annual liability insurance.

Mayor Quentin Meyers reported:

- An estimate from Keller Electric for \$8,771.20 for installation of lights at the ballfields was received. After discussion:
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the estimate as presented. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden reported:

- Building permit B-25004 needs approval.
 - ◆ Whitney moved to approve the permit as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Building permit B-25005 needs approval.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the permit as presented. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Building permit B-25006 needs approval.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the permit contingent upon Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune approval. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Would like to order chat for sealing streets.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the purchase of chat for a cost not to exceed \$18,000.00. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Would like to purchase a 2021 Chevrolet pickup from Keller Motors.

- ◆ Weltmer moved to allow the purchase of a truck from Keller Motors for a cost not to exceed \$30,000.00. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- A water pump on one of the trucks needs repair.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the repair for cost of \$1,556.64. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Attorney Micheal Baxter reported:

- Detailed and presented an agreement between USD 270, KDOT, and the City. Mari Tucker was consulted over the phone. After review and discussion, the City Attorney will contact the USD 270 representative for further clarification and possible amendments.

City Councilmember Ryan Weltmer reported:

- Would like to research different types of mulch that may be used at the park.

City Councilmember Skylar Rudman reported:

- The old, damaged slides at the park have been replaced with new ones.

City Councilmember Matt Whitney reported:

- Would like to research the possibility of finding a location for another park area on the East side of the City.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:02 PM.
