

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, James Balthazor, and Ryan Weltmer.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from April 2, 2019. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$131,404.61. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Randy Hrabe with Northwest Kansas Housing asked the Council if they would consider purchasing two properties and donating them for the building of two single family homes. The Council informed Hrabe that there were already two properties purchased and available; the City would not purchase any additional real estate.

Randy Prater informed the Council as to the condition on the streets near his home. The Council stated they are aware of the street issues and are working to correct them.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- A preliminary 2018 financial statement has been included as part of the Council's packets.
- Compliance letters regarding lawn care and erosion control are being sent.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- The fire department will be hosting a fire school on June 1-2.
- Wise presented a Mutual Aid Agreement for Council consideration between Ellis County and the Plainville Fire department.
  - ◆ Sherraden moved to accept the agreement as presented. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- He and Jay Hrabe attended a training session about sewer lift stations.
- Would like an executive session for matters of non-elected personnel.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body, City Attorney Michael Baxter, City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher, and Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 8:15 PM. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

- The Governing Body, City Attorney Michael Baxter, City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher, and Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman returned to the table at 8:15 PM with no action taken.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:23 PM.
