

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Daryl Sherraden, Colton Wise, James Balthazor, and Deb Meyers. Ryan Weltmer was present by video conference.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from March 16, 2021. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$164,468.42. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The public hearing for the property listed as 413 West Mill Street as per Resolution Number 229 was open at 7:03 PM. After discussion with the owner of the property:

- Balthazor moved to declare the property known as 413 West Mill Street as a dangerous structure. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The public hearing was closed at 7:15 PM.

Mayor Quentin Meyers reported:

- Senator Jerry Moran's office has expresses interest in investigating grant opportunities for the building addressed as 217 & 219 Mill Street.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Police Captain Chris Davis was presented with a plaque commemorating his 20th year of working for the City.
- A building permit highlighting a curb cut at Astra Bank was presented for approval.
 - ◆ Deb Meyers moved to approve the permit as presented. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Would like to have Midco Diving preform preventative maintenance procedures on the water reservoir and booster station. The cost was estimated at \$2,998.00. After discussion:
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow Midco Diving to preform the necessary work for a cost not to exceed \$4,500.00. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Has met with EBH Engineering to discuss details needed for the Preliminary Engineering Report and the design of Well Number 19.

Councilmember Daryl Sherraden reported:

- Would like an executive session to discuss an employee related issue.

- ◆ Sherraden moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel, to protect the privacy of those involved, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 8:20 pm. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- ◆ The Governing Body returned to the table at 8:20 PM with no action taken.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:21 PM.
