

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Daryl Sherraden, James Balthazor, Colton Wise, Ryan Weltmer, and Deb Meyers.

All stood for the flag salute.

Weltmer moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from May 4, 2021. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$68,752.07. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to open the CDBG-CV public hearing as advertised at 7:01 PM. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed. There were no public comments.

Balthazor moved to close the CDBG-CV public hearing as advertised at 7:05 PM. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

- Sherraden moved to approve Resolution 231: Application for CDBG Funds as presented. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Deb Meyers moved to accept the Agreement for Administrative Services of CDBG Funds between the City and Northwest Kansas Planning and Development. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mike Younger with EBH Engineering addressed the Council as to the different delivery options available for City water services.

Kelli Hansen shared the schedule for the upcoming Paradise Creek Festival and asked if the City would be willing to pay for the rental of an event tent.

- Weltmer moved to allow up to \$2,500.00 to be used for the Paradise Creek Festival. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- An invoice for Don's Electric in the amount of \$2,038.01 needs approval.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the invoice from Don's Electric in the amount of \$2,038.01. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Have received a \$14,348.10 dividend refund from EMC Insurance.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- The City-wide cleanup is progressing well.

Compliance Officer Mandy Bice reported:

- A liquor license from June 1, 2021 – May 31, 2023 for Leo's Liquor and an event license for the Plainville Saddle Club for June 11, 2021 – June 13, 2021 needs approval.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve both licenses as presented. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed with Sherraden voting Nay.


Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:
