

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were James Balthazor, Skylar Rudman, Matt Whitney, and Frank Austin. Ryan Weltmer was absent.

Balthazor moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the permit as presented. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.


Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:
