

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, James Balthazor, and Ryan Weltmer.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Haas moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from May 7, 2019. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$67,195.40. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Lifeguard and swimming pool manager pay was discussed by the Council. After discussion:

- Balthazor moved to increase the hourly wage of returning lifeguards by twenty-five cents per hour and raise the salary of the swimming pool managers by \$25.00 per week. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

A Cereal Malt Beverage license for the Plainville Saddle Club and a liquor license for Leo's Liquor need Council approval.

- Haas moved to approve the CMB license for the Plainville Saddle Club from 12:00 PM June 7, 2019 to 12:00 AM June 9, 2019 and the liquor license for Leo's Liquor from June 1, 2019 to May 31, 2021. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed with Sherraden voting nay.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- The cost to increase insurance coverage for the three sewer lift stations through Plainville Insurance Agency will be \$1,074.00.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to accept the increase and approve the invoice for Plainville Insurance Agency in the amount of \$1,074.00. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- A demonstration with a different web hosting provider will be scheduled. Compliance Officer Bice will also view the demonstration.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Captain Chris Davis has vacation hours that exceed the maximum and will be lost at his anniversary hiring date.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow the exceeded hours to be retained and carried over into the next year. Sherraden seconded them motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Pool chemicals are needed for this year.

- ◆ Sherraden moved to allow for the purchase of pool chemicals as needed not to exceed \$8,000.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Sherraden moved to adjourn the meeting. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:51 PM.
