

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were, Daryl Sherraden, Skylar Rudman, Colton Wise, and Deb Meyers. James Balthazor was not present.

All stood for the flag salute.

Sherraden moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from April 19, 2022. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$88,065.2. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mayor Quentin Meyers recommended Troy Rudman for Chief of Police, Michael Baxter for City Attorney, Scott R. Barrows for City Municipal Judge, Lee McVey for City Prosecutor, Jim Mesecher for City Administrator/Clerk, Lorrie Bland for Assistant City Clerk, Cassandra Nuckols for City Treasurer, Craig Wise for Fire Chief, Ryan Cellmer for City Fire Department Secretary-Treasurer, 1st State Bank and Astra Bank as Depository of City Funds, and the Plainville Times as the Official City Newspaper.

- Deb Meyers moved to accept and appoint all recommendations. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Justin Plante with the Plainville Recreation Commission asked if the Council would help with the costs of repairs to several bleachers at the ballfields. There was no objection to having Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune help in determining how many bleachers need repair.

Councilmember James Balthazor arrived at the meeting.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Well number 23 has been completed.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Inquired as the possibility of on-call pay for officers. The Emergency Services Committee will research the possibility.
- Based on citizens' input, the noonday whistles will remain active.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Will be filling the swimming pool next week.
- Flushing of the hydrants is proceeding.

Compliance Officer Many Bice reported:

- A building permit detailing a curb cut at 803 South Broadway needs approval.

- ◆ Balthazor moved approve the permit as presented. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- A Cereal Malt Beverage license needs approval for Family Dollar.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the CMB license for Family Dollar as presented. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed with Sherraden voting Nay.
- An event license allowing the sale of Cereal Malt Beverages for the Plainville Saddle Club for June 10, 2022 – June 12, 2022 needs approval.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the license as presented. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed with Sherraden voting Nay.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- Repairs to the cascade compressor have been completed.
- The Fire Department golf tournament was well attended.


City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:
