

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, James Balthazor, Skylar Rudman, Matt Whitney, and Frank Austin.

All stood for the flag salute.

Weltmer moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- April 15, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$210,750.08
- KDHE drawdown #10 and EBH invoice \$7,538.00

Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mayor Quentin Meyers recommended Michael Baxter for City Attorney, Scott R. Barrows for City Municipal Judge, Jim Mesecher for City Administrator/Clerk, Cassandra Nuckols for City Treasurer, Craig Wise for Fire Chief, Ryan Cellmer for City Fire Department Secretary-Treasurer, 1st State Bank and Astra Bank as Depository of City Funds, and the Plainville Times as the Official City Newspaper.

- Balthazor moved to accept and appoint all recommendations. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mayor Quentin Meyers recommended Troy Rudman for Chief of Police.

- Balthazor moved to accept and appoint Troy Rudman for Chief of Police. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed with Skylar Rudman abstaining.

Brett Waggoner with Governmental Assistance Services (GAS) gave a description of the services that GAS could provide to the City.

USD 270 school board President Chris Hansen detailed the Safe Routes to School plan. After discussion:

- Balthazor moved to approve the agreement between the Secretary of Transportation, USD 270, and the City as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Presented an estimate in the amount of \$50,600.00 for new municipal software from Edmonds GovTech. After discussion:
 - ◆ Austin moved to allow the purchase of municipal software as presented. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden reported:

- Building permit B-25007 needs approval.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the permit as presented. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Has ordered chat for sealing streets.
- Testing needs to be done on the splash pad.
- Discussed landscaping and mulch barrier options for the City Park.
- The stage is being repaired.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Would like an executive session for the discussion of non-elected personnel.
- Weltmer moved to recess into executive session to discuss matters involving non-elected personnel, to include the Governing Body, Police Chief Troy Rudman, and Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 8:13 PM. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.
 - ◆ The Governing Body, Police Chief Troy Rudman, and Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden returned to the Council Chamber at 8:13 PM with no action taken.

City Attorney Micheal Baxter reported:

- Presented an amendment to a real estate agreement between Red Mountain Construction and the City.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to accept the agreement as presented. Whitney seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Presented an agreement between Downtown Plainville Incorporated and the City regarding the property at 322 West Mill Street. After discussion:
 - ◆ Whitney moved to accept the agreement as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Councilmember Frank Austin reported:

- Researching banner options.

City Councilmember Ryan Weltmer reported:

- Fire Chief's truck needs lights installed for a cost of \$2,500.00.
 - ◆ Austin moved to allow the installation for a cost not to exceed \$2,500.00. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Has consulted with the pool manager regarding the vacant assistant pool manager position.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to offer the assistant pool manager position to Sara Eichman for \$500.00 per week and increase Peggy Axelson's weekly wage to \$550.00 per week. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Councilmember Matt Whitney reported:

- A Strategic Doing session has been scheduled for May 14th at 6:30PM.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:31 PM.
