

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Daryl Sherraden, Colton Wise, James Balthazor, and Deb Meyers. Ryan Weltmer was absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from June 1, 2021. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$73,434.54. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

A preliminary draft of the 2022 Budget was presented, and discussion was held regarding changes. A public hearing date will be set at a future regular meeting.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Customers' utility deposits are being credited back to their accounts.
- A meeting with the Governing Bodies of the City of Stockton and the City of Plainville to discuss water treatment options is scheduled for June 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 PM at the Rooks County Sheriff's office.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- The City has sprayed for mosquitoes.
- The streets will be sprayed for weeds.


Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- Truck number 512 needs repairs. The cost should not exceed \$1,400.00.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow the repairs for a cost not to exceed \$1,400.00. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The air conditioning in the fire house is not working. It was inspected by a technician and needs to be replaced.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow the replacement of the air conditioning unit in the fire house for a cost not to exceed \$3,600.00. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- The Release of Leases and Assignment of Interest between the City and the Public Building Commission needs approval.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the Release of Leases and Assignment of Interest as presented. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
