

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in special session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 2:30 PM. Council Members present were James Balthazor, Colton Wise, and Deb Meyers.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from May 17, 2022 and pay bills in the amount of \$115,704.12. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mayor Meyers recommended appointing Ryan Weltmer to fill the vacant Council seat and to appoint him as Council President.

- Balthazor moved to appoint Ryan Weltmer as a Councilmember and Council President. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Weltmer was sworn in and took his seat.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- Water Well #20 needs repairs in the amount of \$31,241.85.
 - ◆ Deb Meyers moved to allow the repairs as presented. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The reservoir needs cleaning. Midco Services will be able to complete the task next week for a cost not to exceed \$3,000.00.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow Midco to clean the reservoir for a cost not to exceed \$3,000.00. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 2:35 PM.
