

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, Skylar Rudman, Matt Whitney, and Frank Austin. James Balthazor was absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Weltmer moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- Bills in the amount of \$95,107.22

Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Would like an executive session for the discussion of non-elected personnel.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to recess into executive session to discuss matters involving non-elected personnel, to include the Governing Body, City Attorney Michael Baxter, Police Chief Troy Rudman, and Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 7:08 PM. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Compliance Officer Daryl Sherraden reported:

- An event license for the library needs approval.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve an event license for the Plainville Library for July 30th. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Building permits B25-014 and B25-015 need approval.
 - ◆ Weltmer moved to approve both permits as presented. Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- Sent a letter to Main Street Development regarding the two-story abandoned building on Mill Street asking if they would secure the location and attend the August 5th regular meeting.

City Councilmember Frank Austin reported:

- Presented banner designs. 60 Banners will cost approximately \$5,200.00. Will research funding options.

City Councilmember Ryan Weltmer reported:

- The Housing Authority is asking for help with laying decorative rock in specific locations and for the purchase of new mailboxes. The cost would be \$1,768.00 for rock and \$2,340.05 for the mailboxes. Will research funding options and report back at the next meeting.

City Councilmember Matt Whitney reported:

- Gave updates on Redbud Village.
- Moved to hire Governmental Assistance Services to perform a Low to Moderate Income survey for a cost of \$6,480.00. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Moved to recess into executive session to discuss matters involving non-elected personnel, to include the Governing Body and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 7:56 PM. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Governing Body returned to the Council Chamber at 7:56 PM.
 - ◆ Moved to increase the City Treasurer's wage by \$50.00 per month effective this current pay period. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.
