

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Daryl Sherraden, Ryan Weltmer, Colton Wise, James Balthazor, and Deb Meyers.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from July 6, 2021. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$93,108.30. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Tom Carpenter with Mapes & Miller LLP presented and reviewed the 2020 Audit with a clean opinion by the firm.

- Weltmer moved to accept the 2020 Audit as presented by Mapes & Miller LLP. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Two bids for the drilling of water well number 23 were submitted. Downey Drilling submitted a bid of \$132,131.50 and Clark Well submitted a bid of \$152,550.00.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to accept the bid from Downey Drilling in the amount of \$132,131.50 and allow the mayor to sign the notice of award contingent upon the City Attorney's review and approval. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- B&B has submitted a bid of \$5,800.00 for repairs to an intersection along 8th street.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to accept the bid of \$5,800.00 from B&B to repair the intersection. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The street sweeper will need repair and maintenance. Costs for the repairs will be presented at a future meeting.

A Community Block Development Grant contract between the Kansas Department of Commerce and the City of Plainville was presented for approval.

- Deb Meyers moved to approve the CDBG-CV3 contract between KDOC and the City as presented. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- The first installment of \$136,839.36 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) has been deposited into the bank. The seconded installment of the same amount is scheduled to be deposited approximately one year from the first.
- CBC Plainville LLC has submitted a building permit that may require a curb cut along South 7th Street.

- ◆ Weltmer moved to allow a curb cut as detailed in the permit. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- A suggested date for acceptance of business applications for the approved CDBG-CV3 grant is August 9th through the 31st. There was no objection to this timeframe.


Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
 - ◆ The Governing Body City, Police Chief Troy Rudman, and the City Attorney returned to the Council Chamber at 7:50 PM.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to increase Officer Lee Vogel's hourly wage by \$.75 per hour and pay \$15.50 per hour to certified part-time officers. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Councilmember Deb Meyers reported:

- Would like to investigate alternative locations for the ballot box currently located outside the City Office.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 8:12 PM.
