Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from August 3, 2021. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

 - ◆ Balthazor moved to increase Officer Blake Rogers' wage to \$18.50 per hour. Wise seconded the motion. The motion passed.


Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:
