

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, James Balthazor, Skylar Rudman, Matt Whitney, and Frank Austin.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- August 5, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$163,393.46

Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Fire Chief Craig Wise reported:

- Hays Fire and Rescue has given a proposal of \$528,997.00 for one Rosenbauer Pumper truck. The City will make a down payment to Community Leasing Partners of \$210,000.00 and finance through Community Leasing Partners as a capital lease with a maturity date of March 1, 2036.
  - Weltmer moved that the form and content of the "Master Equipment Lease Purchase Agreement" with Community Leasing Partners Division of Community First National Bank with attached Exhibit "A" Schedule of Equipment, Attachment 1 equipment description, Attachment 2 payment schedule, Exhibit "B" Lessee Resolution, Exhibit "D" Acceptance Certificate, the Title Registration and Security Interest Certification, the Bank Qualified Certificate in regards to Exhibit "A", the Insurance Coverage Requirements, Notice of Assignment, the Escrow Agreement with the Community First National Bank (Escrow Agent), the Escrow Agreement Exhibit "A", the Tax Compliance Agreement and No Arbitrage Certificate in regards to Exhibit "A", the IRS form 8038-G, and the proposal with Hays Fire and Rescue and Rosenbauer in the amount of \$528,997.00, all be accepted and signed based on review and approval by the City Attorney, and that a down payment of \$210,000.00 from the Equipment Reserve Fund be disbursed to Community Leasing Partners and be placed into the Escrow holding account. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Working on hosting a fire school in the future.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- Gathering information to send compliance letters.


City Councilmember Skylar Rudman reported:
