

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Daryl Sherraden, Ryan Weltmer, Colton Wise, James Balthazor. Deb Meyers was absent.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from July 20, 2021. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$75,019.59. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mayor Quentin Meyers reported:

- The cost to repair the street sweeper from Key Equipment is \$8,601.21.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow the street sweeper to be repaired by Key Equipment for \$8,601.21. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Street patching material is needed from APAC for a cost of \$1,350.28.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow the purchase from APAC for \$1,350.28. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.


Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:
