

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Colton Wise, Ryan Weltmer, Daryl Sherraden, and Deb Meyers. James Balthazor was absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Weltmer moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from July 21, 2020. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$102,770.01. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Roger Hrabe with Rooks Economic Development presented a Development Opportunity Profile for the City.

Adam Comeau inquired as to whether the platted NW 1<sup>st</sup> Street between Plainville and Commercial Avenues could be vacated. City Attorney Michael Baxter will research the possibility.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- A real estate purchase agreement for the purchase of property between the City and Ryan Reese was presented.
  - ◆ Weltmer moved to accept the agreement as presented. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Four bids were received and opened regarding the leasing of farmland from the City. The high bid was from Russell McDowell at \$65.50 per acre. The City Attorney will prepare a lease agreement.
- The Council has no objection to a closing date of August 16<sup>th</sup> for the swimming pool.


Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:
