

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, James Balthazor, Matt Whitney, Skylar Rudman, and Frank Austin.

All stood for the flag salute.

Weltmer moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- Corrected September 2, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$112,858.64

Rudman seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Riley Rogers presented an Eagle Scout project he would like to complete consisting of placing flag poles with American flags at the Max Malin ball fields. There was no objections to him working with the Plainville Recreation Commission to complete the project.

Mayor Quentin Meyers reported:

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve offering the candidate the Compliance position at \$17.00 per hour. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- The department has completed the sealing of streets.
- Will be purchasing chat for next year.
- The winterization of the park is being completed.
- A number of low hanging trees that are beginning to interfere with traffic need to be addressed.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- Will be working on easements for the upcoming water project.
- Will try to contact the Rooks County Economic Director to inquire about 219 and 217 Mill Street building.

City Councilmember Frank Austin reported:

- Will continue to get pricing on banners.
