

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were Ryan Weltmer, James Balthazor, Matt Whitney, and Frank Austin. Skylar Rudman was absent.

All stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the consent agenda consisting of:

- August 19, 2025, regular meeting minutes
- Bills in the amount of \$313,343.79
- KDHE drawdown #14 and EBH invoice \$7,149.00

Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The Public Hearing to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate as published on the City's website and in the July 10, 2025, issue of the Plainville Times was opened at 7:01 PM.

- Resolution 250, a resolution to exceed the revenue neutral rate, was presented.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to accept and approve Resolution 250 as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed after a roll call vote of the entire Governing Body was taken with every member voting aye.
- The Public Hearing to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate was closed at 7:06 PM.

The Public Hearing for the 2025 Budget as published on the City's website and in the July 10, 2025, issue of the Plainville Times was opened at 7:06 PM. The Public Hearing for the 2025 Budget was closed at 7:08 PM.

- ◆ Weltmer moved to approve the 2025 Budget as presented. Whitney seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Presented a Capital Improvement Plan addition in the amount of \$25,000.00, and a quote from CK Technologies in the amount of \$20,791.00, to be used for computer equipment and installation services.
 - ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the Capital Improvement Plan change and the CK Technologies quote as presented. Austin seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- A business owner has expressed interest in using the City's Physical Improvement Program. After discussion there was no objection to accepting applications and possibly awarding funding for two recipients.

Public Works Supervisor Joe McCune reported:

- The splashpad has been closed for the season.
- The sign at the ballpark is being repaired.
- Contact will be made to the company repairing Highway 183 asking them to make the gutter free from excess asphalt.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- Will be working on easements for the upcoming water project.

City Councilmember Matt Whitney reported:

- Updated the Council on Redbug Village.

Balthazor moved to adjourn the meeting. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:43PM.
