

## USA EPA, in conjunction with KDHE, Lead & Copper Rule for Water Supply Lines Survey

The USA EPA, in conjunction with KDHE, are requiring all Public Water Supply systems to conduct a Lead Service Line Inventory of both the public and privately owned water services within our jurisdiction. We would like to stress to you that the City of Plainville currently, and in the past, has had no lead issues within our water supply system.

We are sending out this survey in our efforts to obtain information about the privately owned (customer side) service lines within the system. If the information cannot be gathered from the homeowner or business, KDHE may require the water supplier to excavate private water lines in order to identify them. This would be very time consuming and expensive to do every private water service line in our community.

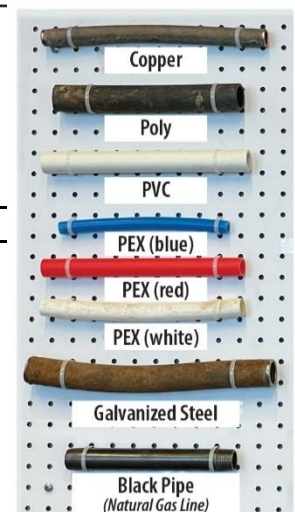
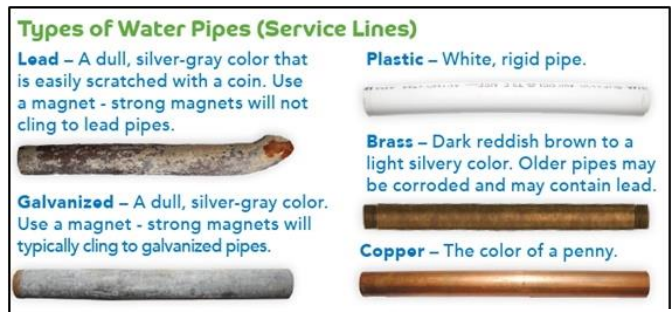
